Many groups create safety and relationship but then shy away from the turbulence or conflict that inevitably arises. They fail to reach their greatest creative potential because *they are not willing to risk the safety and relationship they created*. Radical collaboration calls us to move toward that which makes us fearful, and to address the uncertainties, complexities, ambiguities and grand possibilities that emerge from working together on issues we care about. Learn how to take risks that matter and to move collectively to a place of powerful and innovative action.
